You are organizing a trolley ride for One hundred ninety-five people. If each trolley can seat fifteen people, how many trolleys do you need? Solve and WRITE an equation for this problem.

Mr. Taylor bought two hundred ninety-five new pencils to give his class of twenty-one students. How many pencils would each student get? Would there be any pencils left over?

For a fundraiser, 15 people each donated \$840 to a university. How much money did the university receive?

You need to take 245 kids on a field trip. The buses can hold 25 kids each. How many buses will you need for the trip?
