
BOTH FRANCE AND ENGLAND CLAIMED THE LAND THAT WAS EAST OF THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER.



THE BRITISH WANTED TO HARVEST NATURAL RESOURCES FROM THE AREA BUT...




THE NATIVE AMERICANS WERE ALSO VERY CONCERNED ABOUT MORE ENGLISH COLONISTS SEIZING LAND.



SO MANY INDIAN TRIBES TEAMED UP WITH FRANCE.




HOWEVER, THERE WERE SEVERAL TRIBES THAT SIDED WITH THE BRITISH.
