

The Mystery Castle

Believed to have been installed in the late 1920s or the early 1930s, Mystery Castle was an experience that provide exploration and fun-filled scares.



It was located on the left-hand side of an amusement park, across from the ride called *The Whip*. The Mystery Castle was purposely positioned in the darkest area of the park to spook those who might set off to explore what laid inside.



When explorers entered the castle, they had to walk down a creepy staircase. Hallways were barely lit and cobwebs were everywhere. It was common for a worker to be somewhere within the walls of the castle to make noises or even reach out to try and scare someone.

Once explorers reached the bottom level, an old man dressed in shabby clothing would greet them. He would instruct everyone they would be taking a boat ride that would lead them out of the castle. The sound for the scene included loud chirping crickets and screeching birds. Stunts included a large, snapping alligator, and a skeleton in a torn robe fronted by a snake wrapping himself around a tree. The ride was over once explorers left the castle.
