Rules

- Your Reader must know when you are switching to a new time. Make it clear.
- Using (time) transition words makes your writing flow.

Examples:

Not so good -

Marty saw the puppy, he recognized it, and he picked it up.

Better -

First, Marty saw the puppy. Then he recognized it and after that, he picked it up.

Best -

As soon as Marty saw the puppy, he recognized it and immediately picked it up.
