

## Word Problems To Practice

Alana went to the grocery store and bought 46 boxes of donuts for the students of Van Rensselaer Elementary. There were 27 donuts in each box. The owner of the store also gave her 6 extra donuts because she had bought so many. How many donuts did Alana have altogether?

A researcher estimates that every person uses about 52 gallons of water each day. If that's true, how many gallons of water will 63 people use in a day?

A group of tourists needs rental cars to get around the city. There are 969 tourists in the group. If each rental car holds 6 people, how many cars will the group need?

Each year, the PTA gives teachers in the building a hundred dollars to spend on their class. If one teacher spent \$3 on each item, how many items could the teacher buy? Would there be any money leftover?

Russell's Printing needs to ship 3,384 programs to the Cubs baseball team. The printing company can fit 18 programs in each box. How many boxes will the printing company need to use?

In Michigan, they have several ski resorts. On one ski resort, they have quite a few ski lifts. If each chair lift has 7 chairs, and each chair has 3 seats, how many seats are there in all if they have 5 chair lifts on the resort?

Karina earns \$6 an hour for babysitting. She babysits 3 hours, 4 afternoons a week. After babysitting for 21 weeks, how much money will Karina earn?
